A FOOD SYSTEMS AUDITOR:

- Assesses food safety and quality systems developed and implemented by growers, food processors, packaging plants, distribution companies, retailers, or foodservice operations.
- Validates the effective implementation of food safety systems against a recognized standard or set of criteria.
- Objectively records their findings.
- Applies knowledge of food regulations, food industry systems, and food safety, as well as technical knowledge such as food microbiology, HACCP, and food science.

Key Findings:

- Willingness to Purchase (WTP) for Gene-Edited Foods is generally higher than for Bioengineered Foods.
